Neologist	-A person who coins new words.
Pseudologia	Unreasonably lying in speech or writing.

Prologue	Introduction to a discourse/poem play/ drama.
Monologue	A speech by a person alone.
Travelogue	A description of some one's travel.
Polylogue	A Speech by several person.
Monopolylogue	A speech by a single of many characters in a particular play.
Epidermis	outer layer of the skin.

Dermatologist	- skin specialist.
Pachyderm	animal having thick skin.
Hypodermic	below the skin.
Dermal	- Related to skin.
Dermabrasion	removal of upper layer of the skin.

Cenotaph	an empty tomb in memory of someone.
Taphophile	Lover of tombs.
Taphophilia	Love for tombs.
Taphophobe	One who has taphophobia.
Andropagous	The eating of a man.
Anthophagous	The eating of flowers.
Aphagia	Aphagia is the inability or refusal to swallow.`
Aphagopraxia	the loss of ability to eat.
Phagomania	mania of eating.
Aphagosis	Inability to eat.
Arachnophagous	eating spiders.
Airopagy	excessive swallowing of air.
Carpophagous	fruit eating.
Phagophobia	phobia of eating.
Aviate	to fly in the air.
